

(current) District 60 Council Motion on Division of Funds

I move that all funds of the current District 60, both locally and at Toastmasters International, be divided between the new districts, District 60 and District 86, based on the number of members registered at WHQ in each of the new Districts on June 30, 2008.

(new) District 60 Council Motion to Amend the Bylaws

Whereas the current District 60 geographic boundaries are defined in Article V of the District Administrative Bylaws for District 60 as:

“That part of the Province of Ontario lying between a north/south line drawn through Grand Bend and New Glasgow on the west, and Kingston and Deep River on the east. (Kingston and Deep River are in District 61)”, and

Whereas the Board of Directors of Toastmasters International has approved the reformation of District 60 into two new Districts,

I move the adoption of the following resolution:

Resolved: That the district boundaries in Article V of the District Administrative Bylaws for District 60 be amended by replacing the current boundaries with the following:

“The cities, counties and regional municipalities in the province of Ontario of Toronto, Durham, Haliburton, Kawartha Lakes, Peterborough, Northumberland, Hastings, Lennox and Addington, and Prince Edward.”

(new) District 86 Council Motion to Adopt new Bylaws

I move to adopt the District Administrative Bylaws for District 86 with,

a) the title defined as “Administrative Bylaws of District 86 of Toastmasters International”;

b) the district boundaries in Article V defined as:

“The counties, divisions, districts, and district and regional municipalities in the province of Ontario bounded by: Peel, York, Simcoe, Muskoka, and Nipissing on the east; Elgin, Middlesex and Huron in the south-west; and Algoma and Cochrane in the north-west.”
